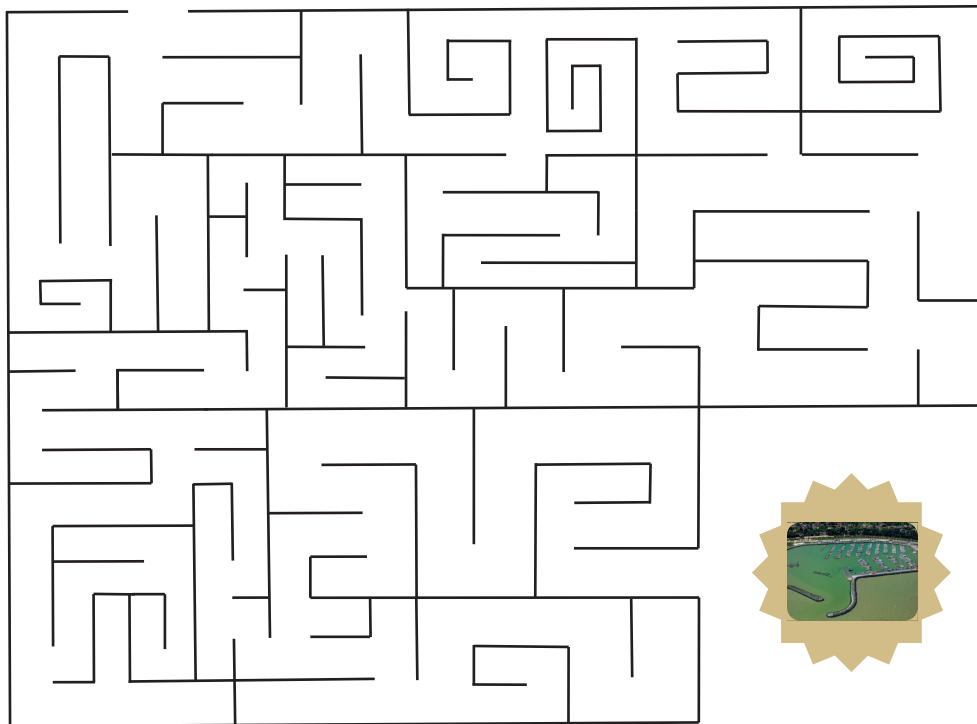

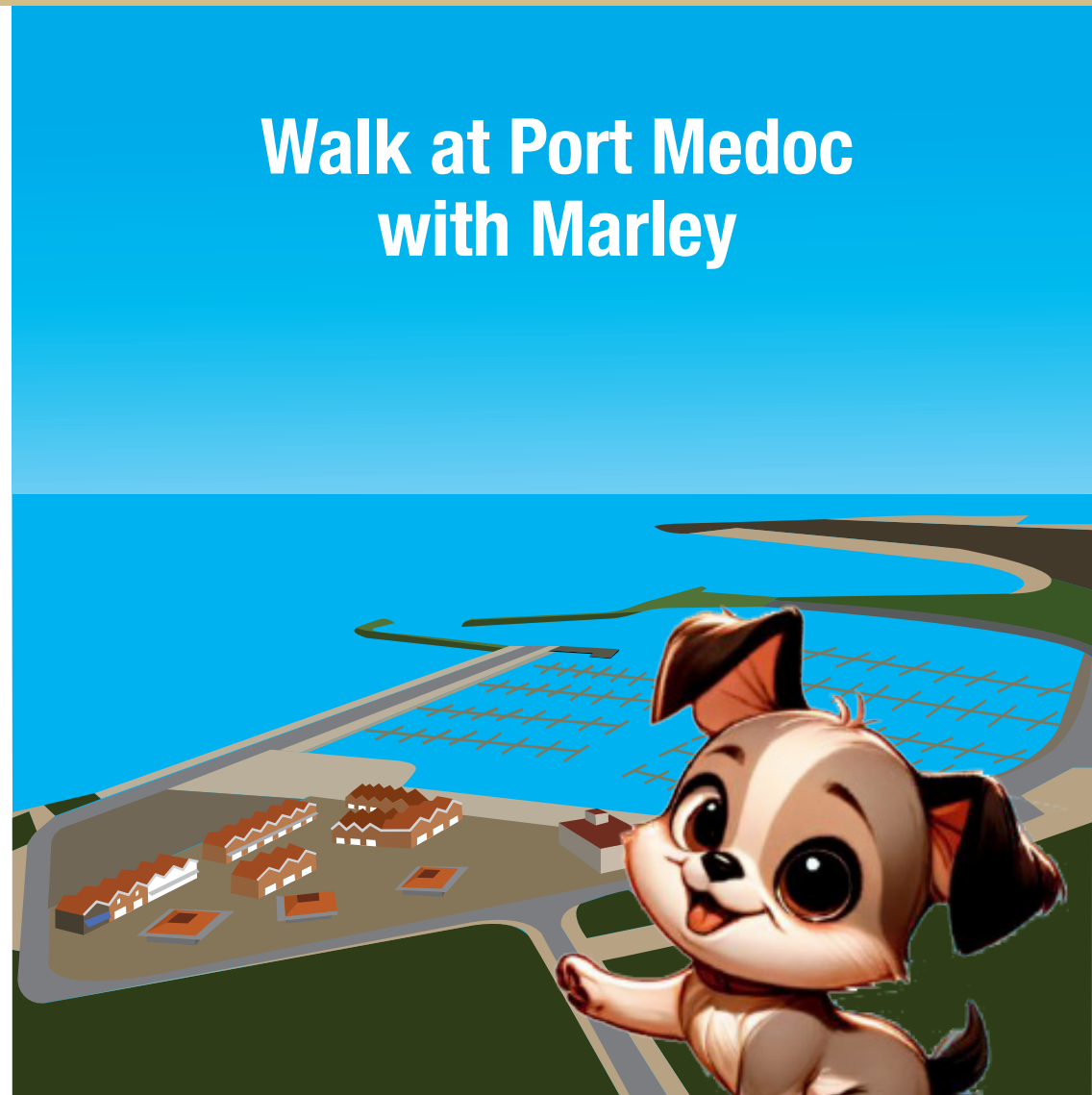

Lets begin ! Go to Port Medoc to begin the course.

Head over to your answer ! Observe well the building you just entered. At the left of the entrance, you'll notice a plaque commemorating referancing Operation Frankton. Using this plaque answer the next question.

Head over to the parking lots at the entry to the port. You must now travel to the Chambrette Beach.

To entre, it could not be simpler : take the alley behind the parkings as indicated by the pink arrow on the map. Make sure not to take the path along the boats.

Near the end of the alley you'll see a wooden gateway that you can cross to access the beach ! Stop a moment at the gateway to observe the landscape... The body of water you see is not the ocean. In fact you are besides an estuary and not besides the coastline !

4 Which river does the estuary water come from ?
