COME DISCOVER THE SECRETS OF THE DUNE DU PILAT!





Hi, I'm Robin!

I often come here, at the Dune du Pilat, with my friends Panpan and Alienor, and I'll show you the spot and its secrets. This winter, we did some archeological digs, and found an old document in the palaeosols! It holds all the secrets of the dune. A part of the document was going to unveil the origin of the sand, but one word is missing in order to understand it! Help us find it!




The **palaeosols** are remains of vegetation, former forests and ancient soils. They form thick black lines under the dune, on the ocean side. They are traces of the various stages of the site's history.





From the reception area cabin, head towards the dune and stop at the last cabin, the "discovery center". Behind it, you will find signs which will teach you about the hidden residents of the dune and the forest.

Using the signs, write down the names in French related to the plants or the animals that you could observe in the surroundings of the Dune du Pilat.



DID YOU KNOW?

Each year, the plover tries to nest close to the top of the beach alongside the Dune du Pilat. It lays its eggs on the sand. Traffic on the beaches is a real threat for the eggs: stamping, predation by dogs...If you want to protect them, keep your dog with a leash, avoid walking on the dune's vegetation and stay close to the water!



The sea holly is a plant currently threatened by the coast damages and erosion. It was chosen as the symbol for the coastal protection agency, the owner of the site.





Try to guess the meaning of the following pictograms, linking them to the right prohibition


















- Paragliding authorised only in specific areas.

I leave you now with Panpan at the top of the Dune! Be careful to respect biodiversity, don't disturb the animals, don't pick plants and keep the sand on the Dune!






Help Robin find his way to the top where his friend Panpan is waiting!



DID YOU KNOW?

The Dune du Pilat is the highest dune in Europe. It is 100 to 110 meters high depending on the years, about 3km long and 600m wide!



Enjoy the landscape at the top of the dune and draw what you see to show Alienor!

DID YOU KNOW?

The dune is moving 1 to 5 meters per year, slowly covering the forest!

The Banc d'Arguin is located to the west of the dune. It is the small island of sand in front of you. Close, on the right, at the entry of the bay of Arcachon, you can see a red and white lighthouse.

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On which sandy point is it?

A. Cape Horn

B. Cap Ferret

C. Cape of Good Hope

DID YOU KNOW?

Until the mid 20th century, resin was collected from these trees, in ceramic pots, to make paint, perfume, soap and more. To collect it, the tree had to be injured, making an incision so the sap could flow out.

This use is a good example of valorisation et reuse of our waste. These can also be used in construction works or animal feeding. This allows to give it a second life: from the plate to the dune!

The sand of the Dune du Pilat comes from the ______ of the mountains (Pyrenees and Massif Central). Over time the _____ wear down and break. They fall into the watercourses. They become smaller and smaller until they form grains of sand. The sand is carried by the rivers to the Atlantic Ocean. The ocean currents then leave the sand on the coast, forming beaches. With the wind, the sand accumulates and forms dunes.
