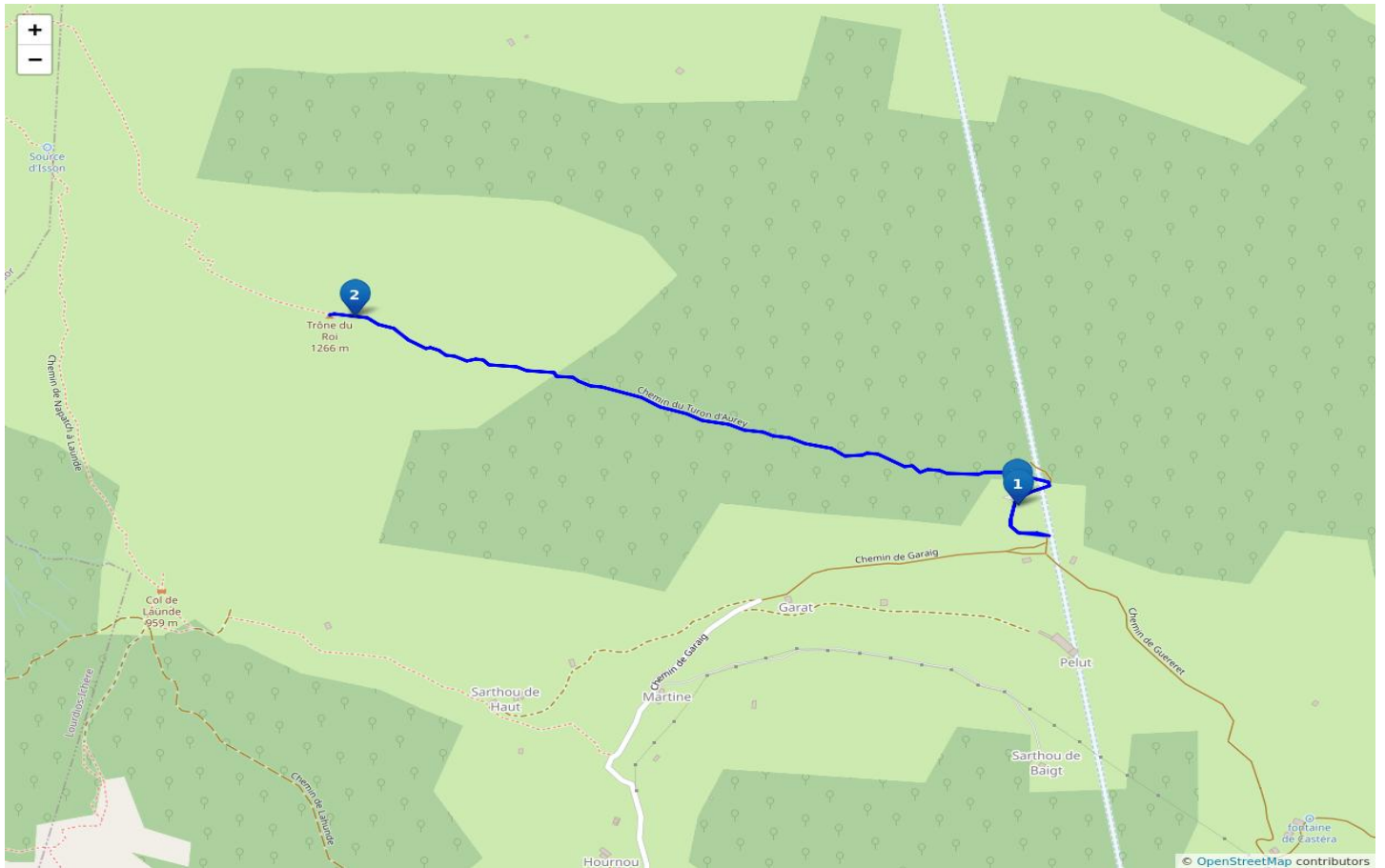

★ À ne pas manquer

- **Pic d'anie.** The views from the peak are incredible, you can see the Pic d'Anie with its little brother the Pic d'Arlas to the south on the right.
- **The King's Throne.** The descent is the same way as the ascent. Be careful in damp conditions as the stones can be slippery. Sticks are handy for keeping your balance.



★ Étapes

Step 1. The quickest. Take the direction of Lourdios (Col d'Ichère) on the RN 134 between Sarrance and Bedous. Straight away about 4 kms and turn on the right until a stone quarry where you can park. Follow the piste that goes past the grassy plateau. It goes along a former quarry after a bend. Hit a path that goes left and follow it as it gets steeper in a flash. After a short and steep section, carry on in the meadow, the summit is near!

Step 2. The dive. The descent is the same way as the ascent. Be careful in damp conditions as the stones can be slippery. Sticks are handy for keeping your balance.
