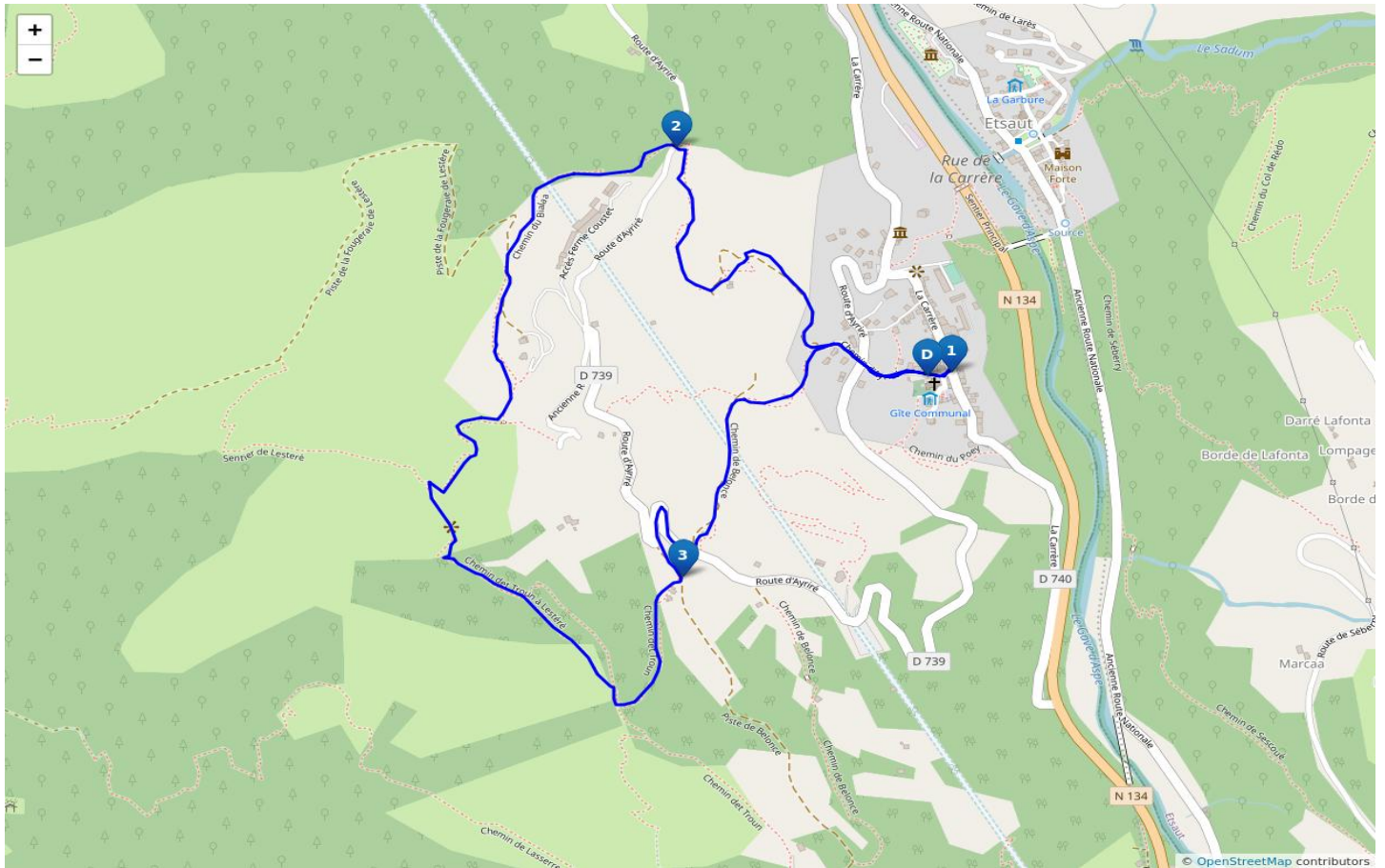

À ne pas manquer

- **Wildlife park.** The bear park is more than just a wildlife park; it's a charity protecting flora and fauna on the mountain. Some animals on the site have been picked up for treatment.
- **Borce Church.** The medieval Saint-Michel Church has undergone countless restorations. It has a black marble font adorned with a St James shell. But other things hide in its outdoor pillars...
- **Maisons médiévales.** Le village comporte des maisons à caractère médiéval.



★ Étapes

Step 1. Ascent above Borce. Church's square. From the washhouse, go back up the street in front of the church and go straight on after the crossroads. At the start of the path, go over the footbridge above the Boussoum and up the track. Take the left-hand path in a bend. Go past a beautiful house and follow the right-hand path by the hedgerow. Walk to the road.

Step 2. open path. Cross it and continue on the path ahead. Pass above a large farm and go straight on along the grassy path. Turn right up a dirt path in front of the house with goes down slightly into a thicket. Cross the stream and go up the GR10 trail. After the first bend in the ferns, take the flat path on the left.

Step 3. Back to Borce. Walk to the left and go down the first hairpin bend in the road. Get onto a path just above the gîte. Carry on along the piste surrounded by a large enclosure: makes sense as it's a wildlife park! Leave the piste and take the GR10 on the right. Go straight down onto the street to reach Borce.
