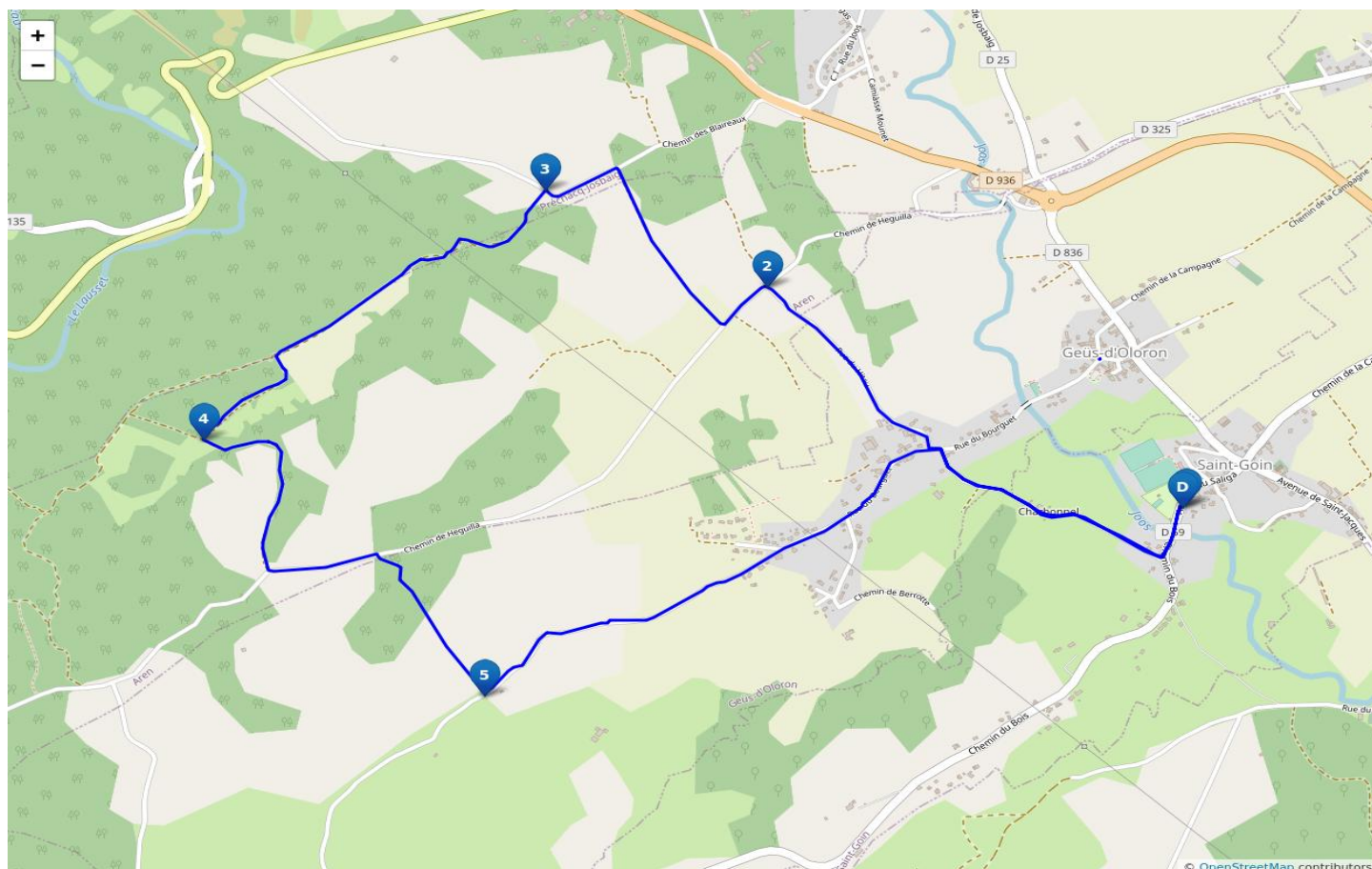

## ★ À ne pas manquer

- **The GR78.** The GR78, or Piemont Way, links Carcassonne to Saint-Jean-Pied-de-Port. It is 520km long and takes about a month to cover. Way of St James, it passes by famous abbeys.
- **Landscape.** As you go down the piste, a fantastic view of the Pyrenees unveils the pyramid-shaped silhouette of the Pic d'Anie.
- **Sculptures.** Funny sculptures adorn the green area on the way into the area. Beautiful wooden deer!
- **Chez Germaine.** Chez Germaine restaurant serves top quality traditional dishes, just what you want after a hike!



## Étapes

**Step 1. Biscays path.** From Oloron Sainte-Marie take the direction of Sauveterre-de-Béarn (D 936). After Moumour, go to Orin on the D 836. At Saint-Goin, take on the left at the church and park after the school in front of the campsite. Leave the car park and head for the bridge. Pass the Joos and turn right onto the little road. At the next junction turn left then right (careful as you cross!). Follow the "chemin des Biscays" after the houses and farm.

**Step 2. Between the fields.** At the end of the path, fork left onto the "chemin des bois" and follow the first track on the right. Walk for a bit between the farming plots and thickets. At the crossroads, turn left and carry on after a 90° bend until a metallic gate.

**Step 3. Way of Santiago de Compostella.** Go up into the woods along the path (GR®78, white and red markers) then go down and cross the Larribau stream. Ignore the left-hand path and go up until a clearing. Leave the GR®78 at the next fork and carry on until the T-junction.

**Step 4. Beautiful view.** Turn left, pass the Balirasse stream and go up a road. Continue on the left and walk on the roadside. At the start of the thicket, go on a dirt path that slopes up steeply for the first few metres. Stay on the path that becomes gravelly and goes down to a road.

**Step 5. Back to the village.** Continue on the left of this country road until you reach the residential area. Turn onto "Chemin Charbonnel" that you took on the way up. Turn left at the calvary and get back to the car park.
