

★ À ne pas manquer

- **Les vignobles du Jurançon.** The Jurançon vineyard (AOC) lies between the Oloron and Pau and their streams. A thousand hectares of Petit and Gros Manseng grapes produce 33,000 hectolitres of sweet dry white wine. The plots are south-facing and look out to the Pyrenees.
- **Les matériaux.** Pebbles tend to be used in building materials along the streams. In the hills you can find old buildings with flat stone exteriors from surrounding quarries.



★ Étapes

Step 1. Ascent! Hit the "toutes directions" bypass from Oloron Sainte-Marie station then follow signs to Pau and the Jurançon vineyard. Follow signs to Lasseube (RD24) at the roundabout and follow the same directions at the second roundabout. Go through the village of Goès and straight on at the roundabout towards Estialescq then Lasseube. Follow signs to Gan when you get into Lasseube. Turn right just before the bridge towards the Belayr campsite. The start point sign is just after the campsite entrance.

Step 2. Hilltop. Go along the campsite towards the N134-Belayr. Turn right onto Chemin Lapastoure (sports trail) and walk to a house. Go up the path in front of the house. It's a steep slope but comes out onto a flat where you fork left when you reach a step. Exit the woods and go along the edge of the field.

Step 3. Towards the Baysole. Continue along the fence then on the edge of the woods. Cross a meadow, pass a thicket on your right and head towards the corner of a vine. Go straight on until the start of the woods and take the path until a road.

Step 4. View of the Pyrenees. Go up towards the houses and stay on this ridge road. After a slight descent, when you reach an old stone farmhouse go straight ahead until you reach the main road. Take a right at the intersection and go along the road for 150m. Turn left following signs for "Domaine Tinou". Go on the backroad by the vines to take you back down to the start point.
