

## The route

- 1.** Departure : In front of the church, take the main road on your right.
- 2.** Turn on the first road on your right, at the « give way » sign.
- 3.** At the bottom of this road continue on the left in the bend. Then continue on this main road until the next crossing .
- 4.** At the bottom continue on the right ( toward « château la Bergère »).
- 5.** At the next crossing, continue once again on the right. Then stay on this path (pass in front of Château la Bergère).
- 6.** At the bottom, Saint-Georges church in sight, continue on the right to pass along it. Then continue straight, you enter back in the village of Montagne. Continue straight again on the road which pass behind the church of Montagne (turning off softly on the left). Continue until the next crossing.
- 7.** Take the first on your right on the road that goes up toward place called « Arriail ».  
Continue on this path to reach the main road higher ( toward château Calon).
- 8.** At the road, go on your left toward château Calon and continue until you find a path on your right (beware the traffic).
- 9.** Take this road to the right toward château Maison Neuve Coudroy.
- 10.** Then, take the first path up to the left (yellow/green signpost).  
Continue until the end of this path and turn left (yellow/green signpost).
- 11.** You are back on the main road, walk a few meters and take then the first path on the right.
- 12.** You are reaching the site of « Les moulins de Calon » (old windmills). Enjoy this quiet place and join then the road in front of you.
- 13.** On the road, take right toward the third mill. At the mill use the path on the right which goes along the trees (toward « Boucle des moulins »).

Go straight down on this dirt track until you reach a tarred road (green signpost).

- 14.** On the road take right and continue until the next crossing.
- 15.** At the crossing, on the main road level, turn right.
- 16.** Beware, get ready to use the path down to the left you've already used earlier.  
Once at the end of the path, you crossed the road to continue straight on.
- 17.** Continue using the path down on the left. and then straight on between the trees and the vines.
- 18.** At the end of this track continue on the path up to the right.
- 19.** At the top of the path turn left and continue until the next crossing at the entrance of a hamlet.
- 20.** Continue on the right until the next crossing.  
Cross the main road and continue by the road nearly in front of you (look on the right), beware the traffic.
- 21.** You continue on this path and you never leave it until you join the main road further.  
It would permit you to follow an interpretive trail about this vineyard landscape set up by the Ecomuseum of Montagne. This trail crosses the wood of Bondé.  
Note that here it is possible to reduce the walk using the path going on the left and continuing straight on until the crossing of the main road 244 where you will turn right to join back the village.
- 22.** Continue to the left.
- 23.** Continue to the right to enter in the wood.
- 24.** Continue straight on until the main road.
- 25.** At the crossing, turn right and walk along the road to go back to the starting point. Beware the traffic !



## Montagne and Saint-Georges




### Description
